ELIGIBILITY

The annual Student Show is open to all enrolled students in high schools and colleges in the extended Northeast Region. Any subject matter and any photographic methods are acceptable. Students do not need to be enrolled in a photography or art course.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- Submit up to four digital files by 9 p.m., Wednesday February 6, as email attachments to ENTRIES@PHOTOCENTERTROY.ORG. Please send only JPG files, 300 dpi/ppi, no larger than seven inches in any direction.
- Photographers must submit a completed entry form. The form is interactive and may be filled in and sent electronically.
- Entrants will be notified which images are accepted for the exhibition by Friday, February 8.
- Accepted images must be finished as matted prints and delivered to the PhotoCenter no later than 9 p.m. Tuesday, February 19. Prints must be securely matted. Prints need not be framed, but it is preferred.
- Finished prints can be mailed or brought in to the PhotoCenter, 404 River Street, Troy, New York 12180,

AWARDS

Cash awards and purchase awards of more than \$500.

ENTRY FORM

“Medium” typically refers to traditional darkroom prints (usually called gelatin silver print (GSP) or digital prints (usually “archival inkjet print”). “Size” refers to outer dimensions in inches, with height listed first. Maximum size for this exhibit, including mat and/or frame is 100 inches in perimeter. All re-

quested information is mandatory. Works submitted may be designated “not for sale” (NFS).

ENTRY FEE

\$10.00 for up to four images by check, cash, or PayPal.

PICK-UP WORK

Work must be picked up within one week of the end of the exhibit as the PhotoCenter will no longer be responsible for it.

SALES / COMMISSIONS

A 30% commission is taken for sales generated via the exhibition. Works submitted may be designated “not for sale” (NFS).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The PhotoCenter reserves the right to refuse any final work that does not contain the same qualities as the images submitted. Prints need not be framed, but it is preferred. Photographers will be responsible for adhering to all deadlines and schedules and for arranging the drop-off and pick up of their work.

All entries will be handled with the utmost care and security will be provided. The PhotoCenter will be responsible for insuring entries while on the premises and will be liable for damage only resulting from the PhotoCenter’s negligence. All work selected will remain on display at The PhotoCenter for the entirety of the exhibition. The PhotoCenter is not responsible for the loss or damage of work during transit, nor responsible for work not claimed by the pick-up deadline.

An opening reception will be at the PhotoCenter on February 22 from 5–9 p.m. Awards will be announced at 6 p.m.
